PRESCHOOL SOCCER LEAGUE

Practices will stress on soccer fundamentals for beginners and install confidence in the kids to compete. The goal of this program is to expose the kids to their first organized sport and encourage them to run, kick and laugh in a team environment.

STREET HOCKEY LEAGUE

Northborough, Westborough and Grafton Recreation Departments are starting a new Street Hockey League this Spring! Each town will have 2 teams for each age group, with 10 kids/team. Each team will play 1 – 2 games/week on Sunday nights for 6 weeks. Teams will be arranged by the supervisors and parent coaches so that teams will be as even as possible. Kids need to bring a helmet (can be a bike helmet or hockey helmet), shin guards and a mouth guard. If a child has their own stick they can use it if it taped at the end appropriately, otherwise we will have sticks available. Gloves are optional if you want to bring them.

SUMMER T-BALL LEAGUE
